Mt. Bachelor will celebrate its 50th anniversary next year. With 3,683 acres accessible by lifts, the mountain accommodates 7 Express Quads, 3 Triple Chairlifts, 2 Tubing lifts and a Wonder Carpet. Average snowfall is 350 inches with an annual snowbase between 150 and 200 inches. The resort features four terrain parks, 56K of groomed and tracked cross country trails, snowshoeing, tubing and dog sled rides and hosts numerous races and events throughout the season. Mt. Bachelor Resort is the fifth largest resort in North America with development and enhancements annually. Among the Company's core values is maintaining and building relationships amongst its employers, guests and neighbors while ensuring everything it does leads to a lasting outdoor lifestyle through stewardship to our environment.
