**MT BACHELOR ANNOUNCES OPENING DAY**

*Bend, Oregon, November 20, 2007* – Mt Bachelor announces opening day Thursday, Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup>. All services including tubing, cross country, day care, ski school, ski corral, demos and rentals will be available. Tickets are \$35 for adults and \$20 for teens (6-18). Children and seniors (70+) ski for free.

“We are working 24 hours per day to put out the best mountain product possible,” says GM Matt Janney.

Lifts will open at 9am Thursday and Friday for service to Pine Marten Lodge and Thunderbird and Skyliner runs. The Sunrise accelerator will service Home Run and Milky Way. For those of you who like to ride features, a combination of 10 rails and boxes will be available. Saturday and Sunday the lifts will start at 8am operating all day until closing at 4pm.

There will be 5k of Nordic trails groomed for skate skiing available for a \$10 ticket. Additionally, tubing will be available for hiking only also for \$10.

West Village Lodge will be open with food and beverage service in Cocoa's and the Clearing Rock Bar, Pinnacles Espresso will be open in West Village and Bachelor Ski and Sport. Rentals, demos, daycare and ski school will all be in full operation.

The Super Shuttle will run Thursday-Sunday and then weekends through December 16<sup>th</sup> then daily through the season. Entry to the Mt Bachelor Park n' Ride is located off Columbia and Simpson.

NOTE: Early season conditions are on the mountain. PLEASE stay on open runs and watch for unmarked obstacles.

*Mt. Bachelor will celebrate its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary next year. With 3,683 acres accessible by lifts, the mountain accommodates 7 Express Quads, 3 Triple Chairlifts, 2 Tubing lifts and a Wonder Carpet. Average annual snowbase is between 150 and 200 inches. The resort features four terrain parks, 56K of groomed and tracked cross country trails, snowshoeing, tubing and dog sled rides. Mt. Bachelor Resort is the fifth largest resort in North America with development and enhancements conducted annually. Recent improvements include hands-free RFID ticketing, two wind-powered high speed quads, two new grooming cats and a new parks program.*
