



Additional Camping Information

- No electric or sewage hook-ups are available.
- We welcome RVs, trailers, campers, sprinters, mobile tiny homes, converted vans, and pickups. Almost any vehicle you are comfortable sleeping in. If you have a fold out tent affixed to your vehicle without a solid roof, be aware that if it's snowing, has recently snowed, or might snow, you will be asked to close it up. We cannot risk your safety if we conduct snow removal operations.
- During winter we do not allow tent camping at the mountain.
- Pay showers are available in the Todd Lake Building at West Village. You can buy a shower token at the Ticket Sales Center in the Mountain Gateway building during business hours. After hours, tokens can be purchased from an on-duty Public Safety personnel. Operating hours for the showers are 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- The West Village parking area is an active overnight snow removal zone. Guests staying overnight in an RV can expect to hear vehicle and equipment noise throughout the night. Be aware that there may be a need to move your RV at certain times to accommodate snow removal activities. We will do our best to inform you in advance if this is going to be necessary.
- Display your permit in your driver's side window. Our Parking Host and Public Safety personnel will monitor the permit system. If your pre-purchased permit is not displayed you can expect to be interrupted at an inconvenient time to ensure that you have a permit.
- All RVs must be occupied overnight due to a potential need to move the RV for snow removal purposes.
- The restrooms in the Todd Lake Building will be open during business hours.
- Please pack out everything you packed in.
- Please keep your dogs on a leash and pick up their poop.
- There is a seven (7) night consecutive maximum stay limit.
