ALPINE

Whether you are an experienced skier or rider aiming to hit all 360° of Mt. Bachelor or a beginner mastering our lower terrain, we welcome you to join us for some alpine winter fun! Our snow-covered volcano is serviced by 11 chairlifts to keep you moving from the 9,063' ft. summit to our 6,300' ft. base area and all 101 runs in-between. New for 2016-17 is the installation of the Cloudchaser lift, providing an additional 635 acres of playful terrain to enjoy, making us the 5th largest resort in the United States.

NORDIC

Mr. Bachelor offers a full service Nordic lodge to compliment 56K of groomed Nordic trails for all skiing abilities. Classic Nordic style skiing is easy to learn and is an excellent way to discover our winter playground. Skate skiing is available for the more experienced skier. Our trained Nordic staff can help with expert advice, rentals & lessons.

TUBING

Experience the snow like never before! Our Snowblast Tubing Park is an 800' ride full of rollers. Surface lifts will quickly take you and your tube to the top of the hill. Gravity will do the rest! Three tubing sessions are available during regular tubing operations (Fri-Sun & all holiday periods) 10am-Noon, Noon-2pm, 2pm-4pm

DOG SLEDDING

A magical experience with the world class Trail of Dreams dog sled team. Jerry Scdoris and daughter Rachel are professional mushers and frequent competitors in the Alaskan Iditarod. The dog teams love to pull and glide you through the snow covered Deschutes National Forest. Trips last about 45 minutes and riders are welcome to help with the dogs before or after the trip. All trips depart from our Sunrise Lodge.

SNOWSHOE

Exploring the Deschutes National Forest with snowshoes is fun, affordable, easy & relaxing. Our Nordic Lodge provides daily rentals, trail and pass information to get you out and enjoying our winter playground. Snowshoe with a Ranger. Join a naturalist for a snowshoe tour at Mt. Bachelor and learn about alpine environments and history of the Cascade Range. Tours are FREE and snowshoes are provided. Tours start at 10am and 1:30pm and last about 90 minutes. SKI STORAGE & DAY-USE LOCKERS

There is no need to pack all of your gear to and from the mountain. Check your skis or snowboards into the overnight storage room and simply pick them up when you're dressed and ready to head to the lift. Overnight storage for skis and boards is located on the upper floor of the Mountain Gateway building. There is no overnight boot storage available. Day use lockers are also available, located on the upper floor of the Mountain Gateway building. All size options allow you to set your own unique entry code which gives you unlimited access to your locker throughout your day on the hill.

TUNING & REPAIR

Our tuning and repair professionals are happy to help with all of your ski and snowboard tuning and maintenance needs. Aside from the weather, properly-performing equipment will have the biggest impact on your skiing or snowboarding enjoyment. So whether it's a wax, tune-up, or repair, we want your equipment to be in top condition so your safety and fun will be at the highest level. The shop is located on the upper floor of the Mountain Gateway building and most services can be completed overnight.

WEST VILLAGE LODGE

Complete with a coffee bar, restaurants serving breakfast and lunch and a full service bar, you can find what you need to keep energized while at Mt. Bachelor. Inside the West Village Lodge, start your day at our Espresso bar and end in "The Rock" bar listening to one of the live bands that play often at our Après parties. This lodge is accessible to all, whether you are on foot or have limited snow sport skills.

PINE MARTEN LODGE

Located at 7,775 feet, this mid mountain lodge has breathtaking views. Its home to a coffee and waffle bar to grab an enjoyable mid-morning/afternoon snack or Scapolo's (Italian for "Bachelor") for an Italian themed lunch. Sparks Café, located on the top floor, is great for a quick bite before getting back to the slopes. This lodge is only accessible for guests with a lift ticket and intermediate or "blue" skiing/riding skills.

SUNRISE LODGE

A favorite among locals, the Sunrise café offers a wide selection of "grab and go" breakfast and lunch items. This lodge is accessible for non-skiers and all skill abilities.
