The Winter Wonderland Tour is perfect for Bend visitors and locals who want to experience and explore as much of our magnificent snowcapped Cascade range as possible. The Cascades are a unique part of the Pacific Ocean's Ring of Fire, the ring of volcanoes and associated mountains around the Pacific Ocean. In fact, all of the eruptions in the contiguous United States over the last 200 years have been from Cascade volcanoes. You'll be front and center to see the after effects of our last "big one" at Broken Top Mountain 100,000 years ago, revealing the colorful insides of our very own complex stratovolcano and high altitude glacial lake at 10,000 feet.

At the summit of the heli scenic tour you'll be treated to an eye candy view of the Cascade Mountain chain stretching from north to south and including Mount Hood, Mount Jefferson, Three Fingered Jack, Mount Washington, North Sister, Middle Sister and South Sister. This scenic helicopter tour includes aerial views of the City of Bend, the Old Mill District and the Deschutes River as well as the spectacular snow capped Cascade range with it's soaring volcanic peaks. MORE INFORMATION

All sled dog rides depart from the lower Sunrise Lodge parking area. Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled departure time to check in and meet your musher and sled dog team.

Children must be at least 3 years old to ride in a sled. Children ages 3-12 years old must ride with an adult. No more than 4 people per sled. Max weight per sled = 450 lbs. Prices are subject to change.

SNOWSHOE TOURS

Join a US Forest Service Naturalist for FREE 90 minute interpretive tours. Learn about winter ecology at Mt Bachelor and the geology of Central Oregon, the Deschutes National Forest watershed and the plants and animals found throughout the area.

Please dress for the weather; snowshoes are provided and no previous experience is required. We do ask that participants be older than 10 years old and wear snowboots and warm winter clothing. No dogs. No infants in packs.
